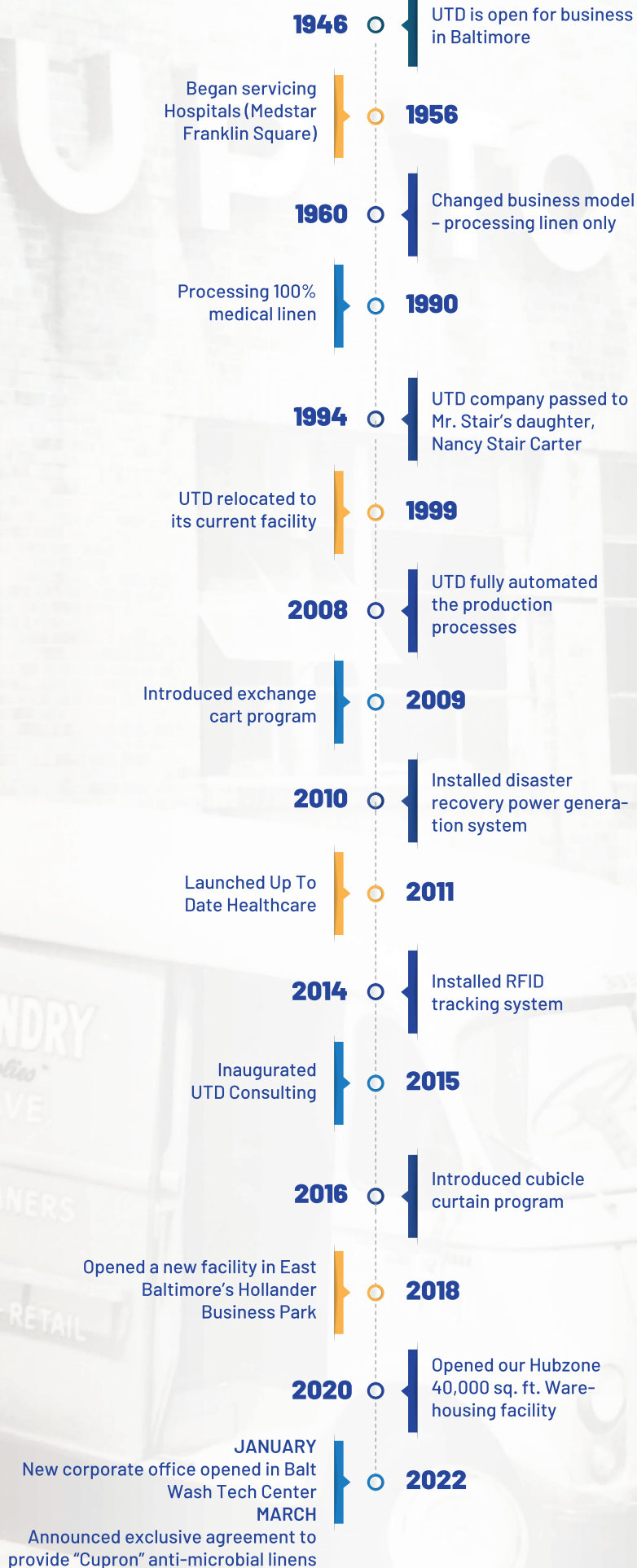
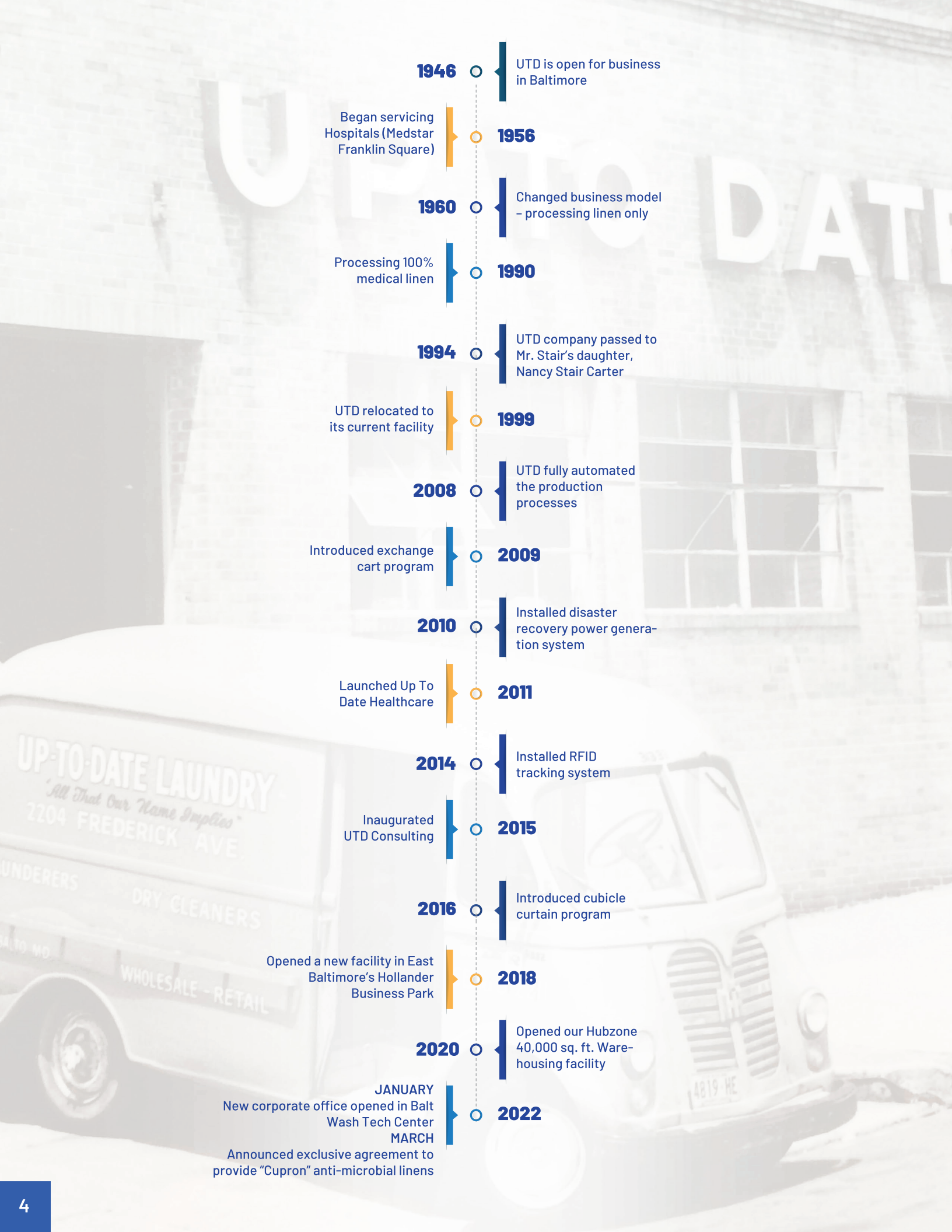

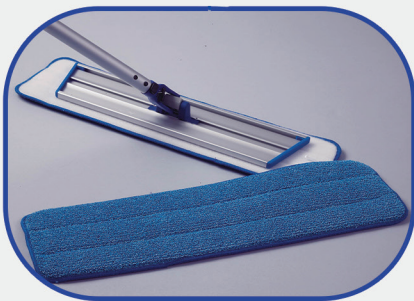

THE CHALLENGE

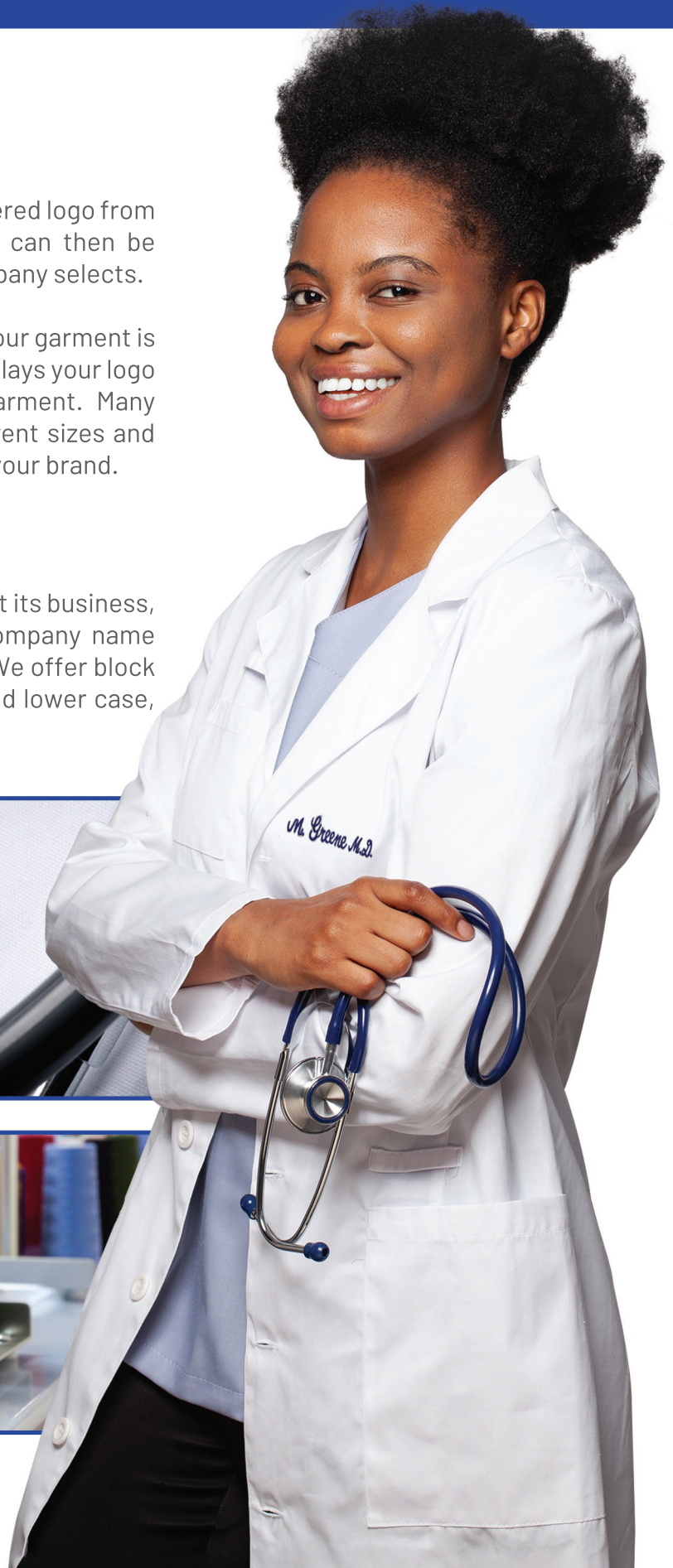
